- Assist patients and families in determining their goals of care and making choices based on their priorities and values
- Coordinate with supportive services such as UCSF Psycho-Oncology and Child Life Services

What is Palliative Care?

Palliative care is specialized medical care that aims to improve quality of life in the face of a serious illness.

Palliative care helps people of **any age** and at **any stage** of a serious illness.

UCSF values palliative care as an integral part of your routine cancer care and is provided concurrently with your cancer treatments.





Symptom Relief

- Pain
- Nausea
- Neuropathy
- Diarrhea
- Depression
- Shortness of breath

- Fatigue
- Anxiety
- Constipation
- Insomnia
- Cough
- Poor appetite

Psychosocial & Spiritual Support

- Determine goals of care and make choices based on the patient's priorities and values
- Coordinate with supportive services such as UCSF Psycho Oncology and Child Life Services

SMS also offers:

- Access to symptom management research studies
- Visits via video, when appropriate, for patients in California
- Home visits for homebound patients living in San Francisco

Interdisciplinary Team

The Symptom Management Service (SMS) is an interdisciplinary team of professionals. Patients are referred to the SMS by their oncologist or primary care physician. Patients will be seen by one or more of the members of the SMS interdisciplinary team.

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
